FULARCZYK took bronze in this event at 2012 OG (with Julia MICHALSKA) and dedicated her bronze medal to her father, who passed away shortly before the Games. MADAJ finished eighth in quadruple sculls at 2012 OG.

NIKOLAIDOU was the final torchbearer on the Greek leg of the 2016 OG torch relay and lit the cauldron in the Panathenaic Stadium in Athens. ASOUMANAKI took up rowing in 2013.
