

## **2019 World Rowing Masters Regatta**

### **Accommodation update**

4 April 2019

### **The organising committee of the 2019 World Rowing Masters Regatta have reviewed accommodation options for the upcoming regatta at Lake Velence, Hungary**

Due to the high interest in the regatta, accommodation is fully booked in the immediate vicinity of Lake Velence. However, there are hotels available in both Budapest and the popular holiday destination of Siófok on the southern shore of Lake Balaton, not far from the venue.

**Lake Velence is easily accessible from Budapest and Lake Balaton.** By car, the distance to the venue is about 50-60 kilometres from both directions and it takes around 30-45 minutes on motorway M7.

In Budapest, there is a huge number of hotels available in a variety of price ranges. There will be minimum 2-3 trains per hour going from Budapest and Siófok to the Velence train station. The journey from Budapest takes about 30-40 minutes on a direct line and about 70 minutes from Siófok with one change in Székesfehérvár. The Organising Committee will provide a 50 per cent discount on your return train ticket during time of the regatta. The trains for Velence leave from the Deli train station and also stop at the Kelenföldi train station, both of which are directly connected to the Budapest Metro.

A shuttle bus service will operate between the regatta venue and the local train stations. Buses will run around Lake Velence, stopping at Agárd train station, Gárdony train station, Velence train station, and Velence Regatta course.
