

FISA Official Notice – 6 September 2016

---

**RE: 2016 World Rowing Coastal Championships in Monaco**



TO: National Federations and competitors

All crews entered and confirmed by their National Federation by the closing date (20 September 2016) will be able to race at the 2016 World Rowing Coastal Championships.

FISA expects a large entry and some events will have qualification races.

All crews should make travel arrangements and preparations to race in qualification races on Thursday, 20 October between 14 :00hrs and 18 :00hrs. Please note that registration for the qualification races will close at 11 :00hrs on 20 October and that there will be a Captain's Meeting especially for the qualification races at 12 :00hrs the same day.

For events with too many entries FISA will announce on 27 September the numbers of crews selected directly to the heats and the number of crews going to the qualification races.

The crews selected directly to heats will be based on the National Federation ranking. All other crews will be required to race in qualification races. Crews that fail to qualify from the qualification races will be ranked and eliminated from the championships.

FISA will announce the progression system from the qualification races to heats on 27 September.

The scheduling of the races may make doubling up difficult and crews are advised that they double up at their own risk.

Please also note that following important dates :

20 Sept 2016 Entries close  
23 Sept 2016 Deadline for NF to rank entries  
27 Sept 2016 FISA publish entries & details of qualification races  
17 Oct 2016 Deadline for NF to make ranking changes
